We can repair damaged cornices and add new decorative plasterwork to your home.




Cement & Lime Mortar Pointing

Damp can pose serious problems for properties, leading to expensive damage. Damp proofing provides protection so you can keep your property safe from water damage.




Ceiling Repairs
